#### LAKE RIPLEY LODGE HISTORY

The family of former Vice President of the U.S., Nobel Prize winner and songwriter Charles Dawes built this charming lake home in the early 1900's. It was reported as the finest home in Southern Wisconsin.

Formerly Maple Villa Hotel in the 1940's and 50's, it was known as the happiest and liveliest place on Lake Ripley.

The Lodge was constructed using local cedar for the floors and maple for the frame. The cedar floors remain to remind visitors of a by-gone era. The exterior is true to the original with a commanding view of the lake and more than 100 feet of wrap around screened porch. The architectural style is like those built by Ford and Edison, with a wide screened veranda and multiple French doors to access the screened area. There are plentiful windows to take in the view and let in the cool lake breeze. Today's lodge has updated plumbing, central air and heat. Bring your laptop computer and access the Internet wirelessly.
